



- Each branch or step is large to highlight progress on annual review reports we use the following:
 - ▶ Starting \rightarrow 0-20% achieved
 - ▶ Within \rightarrow 21-40% achieved
 - ► Secure \rightarrow 41-60% achieved
 - ▶ Upper \rightarrow Over 60% achieved

Example: If a learner has completed Branch 6 and has achieved 32% Branch 7, this would be reported as Within Branch 7



BPVS – Verbal Comprehension British Picture Vocabulary Scale

Type of vocabulary test, ranging from 3 to 16 years
 Assesses understanding of spoken word → not an IQ test, but shows levels of understanding & reasoning

Impact on: following instructions, how we talk and language used, reading comprehension, listening to explanations, learning new vocabulary

YARC – reading comprehension York Assessment of Reading Comprehension

- Tests reading accuracy and comprehension
- Age range from 4 to 17 years
- Read passage & answer questions
- Letter sounds and key words
- Includes fictional and factual passages, and no pictures!

Vernon - spelling

Tests spelling ability, ages ranging from 5 to 16 years
Words become more difficult as the test goes on
Maximum of 80 words, examples of each used in a sentence

EHCP Targets

- Every learner at Silverwood has an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP)
- Progress towards outcomes are discussed and reported at the annual review
- EHCP targets are derived from the outcomes and are a more specific areas to focus on, usually for about 12 months
